- o Cable inlets with secure sealing to prevent loosening and water ingress

Wi-Fi 6 or later versions (Wi-Fi 6E/7) provide higher throughput, better coverage, and reduced interference, which is essential for multiple devices like 4K TVs, smart home devices, and cloud applications . Ensure the gateway can handle the full speed of your fiber connection and supports multiple simultaneous connections. 6. **Installation Type** Determine whether the box will be wall-mounted, floor-mounted, or pole-mounted based on your environment. Indoor boxes typically require less robust materials, while outdoor boxes need higher durability and weatherproofing .
