Step-by-Step Installation

1. Plan the Route Before installation, mark the cable tray path considering clearance, load capacity, and separation from other utilities. Identify bends, tees, and elevation changes to ensure smooth cable management

- o Ladder trays: Open design, good airflow, easy cable access, ideal for high-density installations.

Calculate width and depth based on the number and type of cables, ensuring trays are not undersized (risk of overheating) or oversized (wasting space and money), . 4. Install Supports Use brackets, wall arms, or ceiling

struts, spaced typically every 1.5-3 meters depending on tray type and load. Ensure supports are level and secure to prevent sagging . 5. Assemble and Align Trays Connect trays using couplers or splice plates. Align

straight and level, and handle materials carefully to avoid coating damage, especially for GI or aluminum trays

. 6. Safety and Maintenance Wear PPE (gloves, safety glasses, hard hat) and follow local electrical codes for fill ratios and grounding. Regularly inspect trays for damage or loose supports .
