

How to attach the flange to the terminal box

To connect a terminal box to a flange, ensure the mounting surface is flat, prepare cutouts, mechanically secure the box with screws or adapter flanges, and then complete the electrical connections.

Preparation Steps

- o Check the mounting surface: Ensure the transformer, switchboard, or panel surface is flat and reinforced to support the weight of the terminal box without stressing the electrical connections .

- o Follow manufacturer instructions for any additional drilled holes or modifications to the flange or terminal box .
- o Use only approved tools and accessories recommended by the terminal box manufacturer to avoid damage or voiding warranties .
- o Ensure that the installation complies with relevant electrical standards and safety regulations, including load

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capacity and environmental protection requirements . By following these steps, the terminal box will be securely mounted to the flange, mechanically stable, and electrically safe.
