

How to calculate terminal box jumper settings

Understanding Terminal Jumpers

Terminal jumpers are used to electrically connect two or more terminals within a terminal block, allowing multiple wires to share a common node. Jumpers can be internal (built into multi-level terminals) or external (add-on bars or wires) and may be screw-terminal or spring-loaded . Correct jumper selection ensures proper current distribution and prevents shorts or equipment damage .

Steps to Calculate Jumper Settings

- o Identify the Terminals to be Jumpers Review the wiring schematic and terminal labels. Determine which terminals need to be electrically connected. Use a continuity tester to verify connections if necessary .
- o Determine the Current Requirements Check the maximum current rating for both the terminal block and the jumper. The jumper must safely carry the expected load. If the jumper rating is lower than the block, consider using a purpose-built distribution block for high-current applications .
- o Select Jumper Type and Length Choose between internal saddle jumpers or external add-on jumpers. Ensure the jumper is long enough to bridge the terminals without touching adjacent lugs and has appropriate insulation for the voltage class .
- o Configure in Software (Optional) For CAD or electrical design software, define internal jumpers in the terminal block properties or assign external jumpers using the Terminal Strip Editor. Use the "Insertable jumper" or "Wire jumper" function to link terminals in the schematic .
- o Verify Placement and Safety Ensure jumpers do not cross other terminals or create shorts. Label each jumper clearly, maintain consistent color coding, and follow manufacturer guidelines for torque and installation .

Practical Tips

- o Always cross-check the schematic with the physical panel before installation.
- o Use insulated jumpers for live circuits to prevent accidental contact.
- o Avoid connecting incompatible components (e.g., regulator to resistor) without confirming circuit function.
- o For multi-level terminals, internal jumpers can simplify wiring, but external jumpers provide flexibility for custom connections . By following these steps, you can calculate and configure terminal box jumper settings that are safe, compliant, and optimized for your electrical system.
