

How to connect a fiber optic hot-melt junction box

Insert the terminated fiber into the designated ports of the junction box. Ensure the fiber is properly seated and secured without kinks or sharp bends. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for any adapters or terminal blocks inside the box .

Use a fiber optic test device to verify signal integrity. Check that all connections are tight and functional. Contact your internet provider if necessary to confirm line performance .
