

How to connect fiber optic cables to the panel socket

- o For angled connectors (APC), ensure the angle matches the adapter orientation to maintain low reflection loss .

Step 5: Secure and Test the Connection

- o If the socket has a back box, organize any slack fiber to prevent kinks or sharp bends .
- o Test the connection using a fiber optic tester or network testing tool to verify signal integrity and performance .
