

How to connect the distribution box to the ground

To safely ground a distribution box, connect a properly sized yellow-green insulated copper wire from the PE bar or grounding terminal to a reliable earth ground, ensuring all metal parts and electrical components are bonded.

Steps to Ground a Distribution Box

1. Locate the Grounding Point: Open the distribution box and identify the PE bar (Protective Earth bar) or the grounding terminal marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. This is the main connection point for the ground wire inside the box . 2. Connect the Ground Wire: Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting local electrical codes (commonly 6 mm² or 10 AWG depending on the region). Strip the wire end, insert it into the PE bar terminal, and tighten the screw securely to ensure a firm connection . 3. Bond Electrical Components: If the distribution box contains metal components or devices that require grounding, connect them to the PE bar using additional copper wires. This ensures all conductive parts are safely grounded . 4. Connect to Earth Ground: Run a ground wire from the PE bar or mounting plate to a reliable earth grounding point, such as a grounding rod or central grounding system. Ensure the total ground resistance is low (typically
