

How to connect the grounding busbar to the distribution box and its price

To connect a grounding busbar to a distribution box, attach the PE (ground) wires securely to the busbar using screws or lugs, ensuring all electrical components are grounded, and the busbar is linked to the main earthing system.

Step-by-Step Connection

- o **Locate the Grounding Busbar:** Open the distribution box and identify the PE (Protective Earth) bar or grounding plate, which is the designated point for grounding connections .
- o **Prepare the Ground Wire:** Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting local electrical codes. Strip the insulation for a short length to expose the copper core .
- o **Connect the Power Ground Wire:** Insert the stripped end into the busbar terminal and tighten the screw or lug firmly with a screwdriver to ensure a secure connection .
- o **Ground Electrical Components:** If the distribution box contains breakers, switches, or other components requiring grounding, connect each component to the busbar using individual copper wires .
- o **Link to Main Earthing System:** Connect the busbar to the building's main earthing system to provide a low-resistance path for fault currents, ensuring safety and voltage stability .
- o **Inspection and Labeling:** Verify all connections are tight, mark the busbar clearly for maintenance, and ensure no loose wires are present .

- o **Busbar Material:** Typically copper (high conductivity) or aluminum (cost-effective alternative), .
- o **Connection Method:** Mechanical lugs or exothermic welding (Cadweld) for permanent, low-resistance connections .
- o **Safety:** Always disconnect power before installation and follow local electrical codes .
