

How to find the upstream of the distribution box

To find the upstream of a distribution box, trace the input line from the source--either the septic tank for a drain field box or the main electrical supply for an electrical panel.

For a Septic System Distribution Box

- o **Locate the Septic Tank:** The distribution box receives wastewater from the septic tank. Start by identifying the tank's location using property records or a septic system diagram .
- o **Trace the Outlet Pipe:** Follow the outlet pipe from the septic tank. This pipe leads directly to the distribution box, which is usually buried 6 inches to 2 feet underground .
- o **Look for Access Lids:** Distribution boxes often have small square or round lids, sometimes green or black, slightly above ground .
- o **Test for Water Flow:** Pour a bucket of water into the septic tank and observe if it flows into the suspected distribution box. This confirms the upstream connection .
- o **Use Probing or Metal Detection:** A long rod can detect hollow areas, and a metal detector can locate metal lids if present .

For an Electrical Distribution Box

- o **Identify the Main Power Source:** The upstream of an electrical distribution box is the main electrical supply entering the building .
- o **Locate the Main Breaker or Switch:** The main breaker controls the entire supply to the distribution box. Tracing the wiring from the main breaker will show the upstream connection .
- o **Follow Incoming Wires:** Inside the panel, the bus bars receive power from the main line. These wires are the upstream source feeding all circuits .
- o **Safety Precautions:** Always ensure power is turned off before inspecting or tracing electrical connections. Use insulated tools and follow local electrical codes .
