

How to fix the distribution box to the wall

- o **Check Stability:** Ensure the box does not tilt or wobble. For outdoor installations, consider a waterproof box and add a rain cover to prevent water ingress .

- o **Power Off:** Always ensure the main power supply is turned off before starting installation .
- o **Grounding:** Properly connect the grounding wire to prevent electrical hazards .
- o **Clearances:** Maintain manufacturer-recommended clearances around the box for ventilation and safe operation .
