

How to hang cable trays straight

To hang cable trays straight, plan the route, use proper supports at correct intervals, and ensure trays are level and securely fastened.

Planning and Preparation

Choosing Supports and Mounting Methods

Support Spacing

Proper support spacing is critical to prevent sagging. Supports are typically spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart, with closer spacing for heavier cables . The general rule is: the heavier the cables, the closer the supports should be. Ensure that rods or brackets are securely anchored to walls or ceilings to handle the tray's weight .

Alignment and Leveling

Use a spirit level or laser level to align trays straight along the planned route. Connect tray sections with appropriate fittings and fasteners, ensuring each section is level before moving to the next . For long runs, a cable tray roller can help lay cables smoothly and maintain alignment .

Installation Tips

- o Handle trays carefully to avoid coating damage, especially for GI or metal trays .
- o Use lock nuts or clamps to secure rods and prevent tray movement .
- o For multiple trays stacked vertically, use two long rods and a horizontal bar for stability .
- o Leave slack for cable expansion and future adjustments .

Final Checks

After installation, inspect for loose clamps, misalignment, or unsupported spans. Ensure all trays are level,
