

How to install switches in a room s electrical distribution box

- o Secure Connections: Tighten all terminal screws and use wire connectors where necessary. Double-check that no bare wires are exposed and that all connections are firm ().
- o Install the Cover Plate: Once wiring is complete, attach the switch cover plate to protect the connections and prevent accidental contact ().

Grounding and Compliance

Ensure the metal box and all switches are properly grounded to prevent electric shock (). Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use UL/CE-certified components to maintain safety and compliance ().
