

How to open a bridge archway

Opening or creating a bridge archway involves understanding the arch's structural forces, using proper support (falsework), and carefully removing or constructing materials to maintain stability.

Understanding Arch Mechanics

An arch bridge carries loads primarily through compression, transferring forces both vertically and horizontally to the abutments at each end. The wedge-shaped stones or concrete segments (voussoirs) are held together by the arch shape itself, and any attempt to open or modify the arch must account for the thrust at the base, which pushes outward. Removing material without support can cause collapse.

Steps to Open or Construct an Archway

- o **Assess the Structure:** Determine the type of arch (fixed, two-hinged, or three-hinged) and the materials used (stone, concrete, steel). Each type responds differently to stress and temperature changes.
- o **Install Temporary Support (Falsework):** Before opening or cutting into an arch, construct falsework--temporary wooden, metal, or concrete supports beneath the arch. This holds the arch in place while modifications are made.
- o **Work from the Sides:** For construction, arches are typically built from each side toward the center, supported by falsework or temporary cables until the keystone is placed, making the arch self-supporting. For opening an existing archway, carefully remove material incrementally while ensuring the falsework bears the load.
- o **Maintain Abutment Integrity:** The abutments at each end of the arch resist horizontal thrust. Ensure they are stable and reinforced if necessary, as weakening them can compromise the entire arch.
- o **Use Proper Tools and Safety Measures:** Cutting or removing stone, concrete, or steel requires appropriate tools and protective equipment. Structural engineers should supervise any modifications to prevent collapse.

- o **Load Management:** Avoid placing heavy loads on the arch during modifications.
