

How to plug and unplug fiber optic cable into a router

Fiber optic cables should be connected to a router via an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) using careful handling to avoid damage, and unplugging requires gently releasing the connector without bending the fiber.

Connecting Fiber Optic Cables

- o **Check Your Equipment:** Most home routers cannot accept fiber directly. You will need an ONT provided by your ISP, a compatible router, and the fiber optic cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o **Prepare the Fiber Cable:** Remove any protective dust caps from both the fiber cable and the ONT port. Handle the cable by its plastic housing to avoid touching the glass tip, which is sensitive to dirt and damage .
- o **Plug into the ONT:** Align the connector with the ONT port using the key or tab on the connector. Gently push it in until you hear or feel a click, indicating a secure connection. Avoid forcing the cable, as fiber is fragile .
- o **Connect the ONT to the Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on both devices and wait for the status lights to stabilize, confirming a successful connection .

Unplugging Fiber Optic Cables

- o **Power Down if Necessary:** While not always required, turning off the ONT or router can prevent accidental signal disruption.
- o **Release the Connector:** Press the release tab or gently pull the connector straight out from the port. Do not twist or bend the fiber, as this can damage the cable or reduce signal quality .
- o **Replace Dust Caps:** Immediately cover the fiber tip and ONT port with dust caps to protect the optical surfaces from contamination .

Tips for Safe Handling

- o **Avoid sharp bends:** Fiber cables can break or degrade if bent too sharply. Maintain gentle curves.
- o **Keep connectors clean:** Dirt or oils on the fiber tip can reduce signal quality. Use a lint-free cloth or fiber cleaning kit if needed.
- o **Store carefully:** When unplugged, coil the fiber loosely and avoid kinks.
- o **Check router compatibility:** Some routers have SFP ports for direct fiber input, but most require an ONT intermediary . By following these steps, you can safely plug and unplug fiber optic cables while maintaining optimal internet performance and protecting your equipment.
