

# How to reconnect fiber optic cable to the router for internet access

## Article Overview

Reconnect your fiber optic cable by linking it to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) first, then connecting the ONT to your router via Ethernet.

- o Plug in the ONT and wait for it to boot and register with your ISP's network. Status lights should indicate power and active optical connection (solid green or blue).
- o Power on your router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
- o Access your router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to verify settings and configure Wi-Fi if needed .

### Step 5: Troubleshooting

- o If the connection fails, check that the fiber connector is clean and properly seated.
- o Ensure the Ethernet cable is functional and connected to the correct ports.

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- o Confirm the ONT has power and the optical link is active.
- o For persistent issues, contact your ISP for ONT registration or signal verification . By following these steps carefully, you can safely and effectively reconnect your fiber optic cable to your router, ensuring optimal internet performance and stability.
