



How to reset a temporary power distribution box

Article Overview

To reset a temporary power distribution box, first identify the tripped breaker or GFCI module, turn it off, clear any faults, and then switch it back on following safety precautions.

Step-by-Step Reset Procedure

1. Ensure Safety First Before attempting any reset, turn off all connected electrical appliances and unplug devices to prevent damage from power surges. Make sure the power supply to the distribution box is disconnected or turned off . Wear appropriate personal protective equipment if necessary. 2. Identify the Tripped Circuit or GFCI

- o Open the distribution box and look for circuit breakers or GFCI modules.
- o A tripped breaker may be in the middle position or show a red/orange indicator.
- o For GFCI modules, the reset button may have popped out . 3. Clear the Fault
- o Disconnect all loads from the box.
- o Inspect for overloads, short circuits, or faulty equipment.
- o Correct any issues before attempting a reset . 4. Reset the Breaker or GFCI
- o For a circuit breaker: move the switch fully to the OFF position, then back to ON until you hear a click .
- o For a GFCI module: press the reset button. If it trips immediately again, the fault is still present and must be resolved before continuing . 5. Reconnect Loads Gradually
- o Once the breaker or GFCI stays reset, reconnect devices one at a time to ensure no single load causes another trip.
- o Monitor the box for proper operation and check that all outlets are delivering power. 6. Verify Proper Function
- o Test the GFCI using the TEST button to ensure it trips correctly and resets safely.
- o Use a voltmeter to confirm voltage at the outlets if needed .

Additional Tips

- o Avoid modifying the distribution box or using damaged equipment.
- o Ensure the power supply is adequate for the total load to prevent repeated trips .
- o For long cable runs, consider heavier gauge wires to reduce voltage drop . Following these steps ensures a safe and effective reset of a temporary power distribution box while protecting both equipment and personnel.
