Use SFP+ DAC cables or fiber (LC-LC) for switch-to-switch uplinks instead of copper RJ45 patch cables for lower latency and heat. Avoid tight cable bundling with PoE++ loads. Follow TSB-184-A standards for loose bundling to prevent overheating.
