SFP modules are widely used in Huawei switches, routers, and OLT systems for both single-mode and multi-mode fiber applications. eSFP (Enhanced SFP) modules have the same physical form factor and basic functionality as SFP modules but include enhanced monitoring features. These features allow network administrators to monitor module voltage, temperature, bias current, transmit optical power, and receive optical power, which helps in proactive network management and troubleshooting.
