

Installation Height of Household Power Distribution Box

Preview

The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board. They are exposed type and concealed type. Ground-mounted foundations should be 50 to 100 mm above ground level. The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that the center of the grip of the operating handle of the highest circuit breaker must not be located more than 6 feet 7 inches (2.0 meters) above the floor or working platform. This measurement ensures the panel remains readily accessible to all users.

Residential: The recommended height for distribution board and consumer unit is between 1 metre to 1.8 metre from the floor. The suggested height is 1.3 metres

For the vertical clearance, often called headroom, the space must be clear from the floor up to a minimum height of 6 feet 7 inches (2.0 meters) or the height of the equipment, whichever is
