

Installation Scheme for UAE Low-Voltage Complete Equipment IK10

Article Overview

Installation of low-voltage (LV) complete equipment in the UAE requires compliance with ESMA certification, GSO technical regulations, and LV Switchgear Committee guidelines, ensuring safety, conformity, and pre-approved equipment usage.

Regulatory Framework

LV equipment in the UAE must comply with the Emirates Conformity Assessment Scheme (ECAS), administered by the Emirates Authority for Standardization and Metrology (ESMA). This ensures that electrical equipment is constructed according to good engineering practices and does not endanger persons, property, or domestic animals when properly installed and maintained. The equipment must meet IEC standards, UAE standards, or other relevant technical documents, including safety, electromagnetic compatibility, and mechanical protection requirements such as IK10 for impact resistance. The Gulf Standardization Organization (GSO) provides overarching technical regulations for low-voltage electrical equipment across GCC member states, including the UAE. These regulations define essential product requirements (safety, health, environment) and conformity assessment procedures, ensuring uniform application at entry ports and facilitating trade.

Certification and Pre-Approval

Before installation, LV equipment must undergo mandatory certification:

- o Registration and Application: Submit an application via the MOIAT/ESMA portal, including technical descriptions, drawings, test reports, and compliance declarations.
- o Testing and Verification: Independent or government-approved conformity assessment bodies conduct audits, testing, and documentation verification.
- o Approval and Labeling: Certified equipment receives an ECAS certificate (valid for one year) or Emirates Quality Mark (EQM) certificate (valid for three years), with annual renewal and possible on-site inspections.
- o Pre-Approval for Abu Dhabi: The Low Voltage Switchgear Committee (LVSGC) requires pre-approval for LV switchgear panels, bus trunking systems, circuit breakers, capacity banks, and automatic transfer switches. Only pre-approved products may be installed in customer premises.

Installation Guidelines

- o Compliance with IEC Standards: All LV equipment must be installed according to IEC standards and LVSGC guidelines, ensuring proper mechanical protection (IK10), electrical safety, and operational reliability.
- o Use of Approved Vendors: Contractors and consultants must source equipment from LVSGC-approved

vendors to guarantee conformity and reduce fire or safety risks .

- o Documentation and Technical Files: Maintain technical files, declarations of conformity, and user instructions for inspection and regulatory compliance .
- o Periodic Inspection: For EQM-certified equipment, on-site inspections verify production, storage, and installation conditions to maintain certification validity .

Key Considerations

- o IK10 Protection: Ensure that enclosures meet IK10 impact resistance standards to withstand mechanical impacts in public or industrial environments.
- o Voltage Ratings: LV equipment must be suitable for 50-1000 V AC or 75-1500 V DC applications .
- o Safety and EMC: Assess all risks, including electrical, mechanical, and electromagnetic compatibility, before installation .
- o Legal Compliance: Non-certified or non-approved equipment may result in prohibition of sale, fines, product recall, or administrative penalties . By following these steps--certification, pre-approval, adherence to LVSGC guidelines, and proper installation practices--manufacturers, suppliers, and contractors can ensure safe, compliant, and reliable deployment of low-voltage complete equipment with IK10 protection in the UAE.
