

Installation distance between electrical conduits and distribution boxes

Preview

Minimum distance = 6x the largest raceway size plus the sum of other raceways on the same wall. These requirements prevent conductor damage during installation. A conduit body is a removable-cover section of a conduit system that provides access at junctions or termination points. For power systems operating at 480V or greater, including electrical distribution panels, step down devices or transformers, maintain a minimum separation distance of 6 m (20 ft) from. The purpose of this document is to clarify the WNP-2 electrical separation criteria, describe practices used to implement the criteria, and to provide sufficient information in a manner to simplify verification of implementation in the field. There are no differences in the design criteria. Primary Bonding Busbar (PBB) must be provided and located in the Telecommunications Entrance Room or Space.
