

Article Overview

A Swiss stainless steel distribution box should be installed in a well-ventilated, accessible location at a height of 1.3-1.5 meters, with proper wiring, grounding, and safety checks.

Location and Height Considerations

The distribution box should be installed in a safe, dry, and well-ventilated area to allow natural air convection for heat dissipation and to prevent overheating of internal components . Avoid locations with corrosive gases, liquids, or flammable materials . The bottom of the enclosure should be 1.3-1.5 meters above the ground for fixed units, ensuring ergonomic access for maintenance and operation . Maintain consistent height for multiple boxes within the same facility, with a deviation of no more than 10 mm .

Base and Mounting

Install the distribution box on a stable foundation or base, using expansion bolts or steel nails to secure it firmly . Ensure the box is level and that sufficient space is left around it for at least two people to work simultaneously, facilitating maintenance and emergency handling .

Wiring and Electrical Connections

- o Prepare tools and materials: screwdriver, wire stripper, electric drill, multimeter, insulation resistance tester, terminal blocks, cable ties, and insulating tape .
- o Wire preparation: Strip insulation to expose conductors, ensuring correct lengths.
- o Circuit breaker installation: Install independent breakers according to power requirements.
- o Termination: Connect line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, following color coding standards. Secure wires with screws or terminal clamps .
- o Circuit labeling: Clearly mark each circuit for future maintenance.
- o Wiring layout: Route wires neatly, leaving space for heat dissipation and avoiding sharp edges .

Safety and Testing

After installation, perform the following checks:

- o Insulation resistance test to verify proper isolation between wiring and enclosure.
- o Circuit on/off test to ensure no short circuits or broken connections.
- o Component verification to confirm correct installation of breakers, fuses, and other internal components .
