

Installation of Trapezoidal Cable Trays in Georgia

Article Overview

Trapezoidal cable trays can be installed safely in industrial facilities by following proper material handling, site preparation, and manufacturer-recommended installation practices, while ensuring compliance with local codes and standards.

Material Handling and Storage

Before installation, all cable trays and accessories should be inspected for damage and verified against approved material submittals. - o Maintain Bend Radius: Respect the minimum bend radius for cables exiting the tray to prevent damage .
- o Secure Cables: Lay cables neatly within the tray, using tie wraps or clamps as needed to maintain spacing and prevent sagging.
- o Edge-Wise Orientation (Optional): If installing trays in a vertical "edge-wise" orientation, ensure the manufacturer's guidelines are followed, as this orientation can reduce dust accumulation and is acceptable if supported by proper installation instructions .
- o Covers and Protection: Install solid or ventilated covers if required for environmental protection or electromagnetic interference mitigation .

Compliance and Standards

- o Follow manufacturer installation recommendations and project specifications .
- o Adhere to Cable Tray Institute (CTI) guidelines for material selection, load capacity, and installation

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practices .

- o Ensure compliance with local electrical codes in Georgia, including NEC requirements for cable support systems.

Maintenance Tips

- o Inspect trays periodically for corrosion, loose fittings, or cable displacement.
- o Keep trays free of debris to maintain airflow and prevent overheating.
- o Replace damaged sections promptly to maintain system integrity. By following these steps, trapezoidal cable trays can be installed efficiently, safely, and in compliance with both manufacturer and local code requirements in Georgia .
