While the National Electrical Code prohibits the placing of an electrical panel in tight spaces, it does not outlaw its installation under stairways - as long as the area is spacious enough. Panelboards contain circuit breakers that are overcurrent devices. 24 (F) prohibits overcurrent protective devices from. The building is not providing me the room required to mount the equipment in a room. I have two panels located under a staircase. You. Can an electrical panel be located at a stair landing? It's acceptable as long as the landing meets the code requirement for a safe access area in front of the panel: 2'-6" wide by 3'-0" deep level floor below it, and 6'-6" high clear above floor in front of it [NEC 110. Panels will require access by authorized personnel only and be under the supervision of owner or owner's personnel if they are not readily accessible to the tenant. Wherever you may want to place your circuit box, you must follow the electrical panel mounting requirements dictated by the NEC (National Electrical Code).
