

Is it okay to not install a splitter at the entrance

The most effective method is to install the splitter immediately after a dedicated grounding block, which is the preferred point of entry for bonding the cable shield. While direct, dedicated coaxial cabling is often optimal, resource constraints (like a limited number of wall outlets or pre-existing infrastructure) often necessitate the use of cable splitters. These passive devices, while seemingly simple, require careful selection and configuration to avoid. -Run an appropriate-sized conduit between the utility room/distribution point and the intersystem bonding termination outside (especially important if the utility room does not back up to any exterior walls). 2 limits buildings to one service, but multiple services may be permitted under specific conditions.
