

# Is the Gyx1w fiber optic cable multimode or single-mode

Single-mode fibers typically use laser light sources at wavelengths of 1310 nm or 1550 nm and often have a yellow outer jacket for identification. Multi-mode fiber (MMF) has a larger core, usually 50  $\mu\text{m}$  or 62.5  $\mu\text{m}$ , which allows multiple light modes to travel simultaneously. This makes it suitable for shorter distances, such as within data centers or local area networks. Multi-mode fibers often use LED or VCSEL light sources at 850 nm or 1300 nm and are commonly identified by orange or aqua jackets. Modal dispersion limits their effective transmission distance compared to single-mode fiber.

## How to Identify Gyx1W Fiber Type

- o Check the jacket color: Yellow usually indicates single-mode, while orange or aqua suggests multi-mode.
- o Look for printed markings: Many cables have the fiber type (e.g., OS1, OS2 for single-mode; OM3, OM4, OM5 for multi-mode) printed on the jacket.
- o Measure the core diameter: Single-mode cores are  $\sim 9 \mu\text{m}$ , multi-mode cores are 50-62.5  $\mu\text{m}$ .
- o Use an OTDR or optical microscope: These tools can confirm the fiber type by analyzing light propagation and core size.

- o Single-mode Gyx1W: Best for long-distance links, high-speed backbone networks, and future-proof installations.
- o Multi-mode Gyx1W: Suitable for short-reach connections, such as within buildings or data centers, and generally lower cost.
