

Is the wireless AP plugged into the core switch

Ensure that the AP is plugged into 2 switch ports on the same Ethernet switch that has been configured for LACP bonding. Keep in mind that the maximum bonded aggregate 10Gig wired connection to the switch. Configuration out of the box
