LC to ST multimode fiber optic cables feature LC connectors on one end and ST connectors on the other, allowing compatibility between modern LC switch ports and legacy ST panels . - o 50/125 um core/cladding: Standard for multimode fiber, ensuring compatibility with most network equipment .
- o Low signal attenuation: Typically ≤ 3.5 dB/km at 850 nm and ≤ 1.5 dB/km at 1300 nm, suitable for backbone, horizontal, and equipment connections .

- o Plenum-rated jackets (OFNP/OFNR): Suitable for installation in air-handling spaces, providing fire safety compliance .
- o Durability and flexibility: Can operate in temperatures from -20°C to 70°C , with minimum bending radius of 5 cm during installation .
- o Connector polishing types: Available in PC, UPC, or APC polishing for optimal signal quality .
