



Length of cable conduit entering the distribution box

Preview

The maximum length of LAN copper horizontal distribution cable is 90 meters (295 ft) from the work station outlet to the Telecommunications Closet (TC) patch panel, no exceptions. Where this length would be exceeded the designer will add additional TCs as required. Telecommunications cabling is. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures. Formula: Box Width/Height = 6 x D Where D = Diameter of the largest conduit U-pulls involve conduits. The NEC provides two distinct methods for sizing junction boxes, depending on wire size: NEC 314. 16 (Box Fill): For smaller conductors (6 AWG and smaller), sizing is based on total volume required. Think of it as "The Fill Factor" --every component inside that box gets a vote, and you need to count. Provide Building Entrance (BE) rooms, Telecommunication Rooms (TRs), telecommunication cable pathways, Work Area Outlets, and incidentals as described below and in accordance with the Program Documents.

If the same box had an angle pull, the minimum length would be 18 inches plus the sum of any other raceway

One key point is that on straight pulls the box or conduit body length must be at least eight times the trade size of the raceway. For
