

Length of galvanized steel cable tray

Article Overview

Standard galvanized steel cable trays are typically 3 meters long, with 6-meter lengths available upon request.

Standard Lengths

Most manufacturers produce galvanized steel cable trays in 3-meter (approximately 10 feet) sections as the standard length, suitable for most commercial and industrial installations (EAE Electric, Metsec) . For projects requiring longer continuous runs, 6-meter (approximately 20 feet) sections can often be manufactured or supplied upon request, depending on the tray type and duty rating .

Variations by Duty and Finish

- o Pre-galvanized trays: Standard 3-meter lengths; 6 meters optional.
- o Hot-dip galvanized trays: Standard 3-meter lengths; 6 meters optional for heavy-duty or high-load applications .
- o Stainless steel trays: Also available in 3-meter and 6-meter lengths, typically for outdoor or corrosive environments .

Considerations for Installation

- o Longer trays (6 meters) reduce the number of joints and supports required, which can simplify installation and improve structural integrity.
- o Standard 3-meter trays are easier to handle and transport, especially in tight spaces or indoor installations.
- o The choice of tray length may also depend on the span between supports, cable load, and environmental conditions, which are critical for selecting the appropriate series and material .

Summary

For galvanized steel cable trays, the most common length is 3 meters, with 6-meter lengths available for special requirements. Both pre-galvanized and hot-dip galvanized finishes follow this standard, and the selection should consider installation logistics, load requirements, and environmental exposure .
