

Maximum KPG pipe size for cable trays

The maximum KPG pipe size for a cable tray depends on the tray width, rung spacing, and cable bending radius, with wider trays and larger rung spacing accommodating larger conduits.

Tray Width and Rung Spacing: Ladder cable trays are available in widths ranging from 6 to 48 inches, with rung spacings of 6, 9, 12, or 18 inches. Wider trays and wider rung spacing allow for larger cables or conduits, but they reduce the overall strength of the tray, which must be accounted for in load calculations . For large power cables or conduits, 9-inch or wider rung spacing is recommended to maintain proper bending radii and prevent damage . **Cable Bending Radius:** The minimum bending radius of the KPG pipe or cable must be respected when exiting the tray. If the tray's rung spacing is too close, it may be necessary to select a tray with wider spacing or remove rungs to maintain the proper bend radius . This ensures that the conduit is not stressed or deformed during installation. **Load Capacity:** The tray's load class and support span determine how much weight it can safely carry. Larger conduits increase the load, so the tray must be selected to handle the combined weight of all pipes and cables . For long or extra-long spans, support intervals may range from 14 to 40 feet, depending on the installation environment . **Practical Guidance:** For typical installations, ladder trays with widths of 24 to 48 inches and rung spacing of 12 to 18 inches are suitable for accommodating large KPG pipes. Always consult the cable tray manufacturer's specifications to confirm the maximum conduit diameter for a given tray width and rung spacing, as this can vary by product line .

The maximum KPG pipe size is not fixed but is determined by the combination of tray width, rung spacing, and the required bending radius. Wider trays with larger rung spacing allow for larger conduits, while ensuring that the tray's load capacity and support intervals are not exceeded.
