Types of Metal Cable Trays

- o Ladder Trays: Feature side rails connected by rungs, ideal for heavy cable loads and long spans. They provide excellent ventilation and easy access for fiber routing .
- o Trough or Channel Trays: Solid or perforated bottoms with sidewalls, suitable for medium loads and environments requiring partial protection .
- o Solid Bottom Trays: Fully support cables along the bottom, offering maximum protection against dust and debris, often used in sensitive data center applications .
- o Fiber-Specific Trays: Some trays, like FGS or Basor systems, are designed specifically for optical fiber, including features such as hinged covers, flexible tubing, and bend radius management to prevent fiber damage .

- o Maintain separation from power cables if required to reduce electromagnetic interference, although fiber is generally immune to EMI .
- o Select halogen-free or fire-rated materials for safety in mission-critical environments .
