Secure the tray using approved clamps, cleats, or metal straps, especially for larger cables or bundles exceeding 25 sq mm .

Cable Installation and Securing

Lay cables neatly within the tray, avoiding crossovers. Use tie wraps for smaller cables and cleats or metal straps for larger or bunched cables . Ensure proper bonding and grounding according to electrical codes to prevent electrical hazards . For bends, tees, or risers, use appropriate fittings and maintain smooth cable transitions to avoid damage.

Inspection and Documentation

After installation, verify that all components match the approved drawings and manufacturer specifications . Conduct a final inspection to ensure cables are secure, trays are level, and supports are properly spaced.

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Record the installation process and provide instructions to the supervising engineer or site manager for operational verification .
