Single Conductor Cables enable cables of equivalent construction & conductor material to be functioned at varying maximum ampacities based on how the cables are physically placed in ladder. The use and installation of cable trays is covered by legally enforceable OSHA regulations in 29 CFR 1910. 305(a)(3), or comparable standards promulgated by States operating OSHA-approved State plans.
