Netgear routers cannot directly accept fiber optic cables; you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal to Ethernet before connecting to the router.

Understanding the Setup

Fiber optic internet delivers high-speed connectivity, but most consumer routers, including Netgear models, do not have native fiber ports. Instead, your Internet Service Provider (ISP) typically installs an ONT (Optical Network Terminal), which converts the incoming fiber optic signal into a standard Ethernet (RJ45) connection that your router can use .

Required Equipment

- o Fiber optic cable: Usually a thin, yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o ONT (Fiber modem): Provided by your ISP to convert fiber to Ethernet .

Step-by-Step Connection

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home.
- o Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated fiber port.
- o Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes).
- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the WAN/Internet port on your Netgear router .
- o Power on the router and verify the connection using the router's indicator lights or the Netgear Nighthawk app.
- o Access the router's admin panel (e.g., 192.168.1.1) to enter ISP credentials if required .
