- o **Power Cycle the Device:** Turn off the distribution box for a few minutes and restart it. Temporary electrical glitches can sometimes cause buzzing .
- o **Contact Your Service Provider:** If the noise persists, report it to your ISP or the company that installed the fiber optic box. Persistent buzzing often indicates a defective unit that may need replacement, as noted in user reports of ONT boxes .
- o **Avoid DIY Repairs:** Fiber optic distribution boxes contain sensitive optical and electrical components. Opening or attempting to repair the unit yourself can void warranties and risk damage.
