

PoE switch has signal but no power

Article Overview

If a PoE switch shows network connectivity but fails to power devices, the issue is usually related to power budget, port configuration, cable quality, or device compatibility.

Common Causes

- o **Insufficient PoE Budget** Each PoE switch has a total power budget. If the connected devices collectively require more power than the switch can supply, some devices may receive data but no power. Check the switch's total and per-port power allocation to ensure it meets the PD's requirements .
- o **Port Configuration Issues** PoE may be disabled on the port or the port may be administratively shut down. On Cisco switches, for example, the command `show power inline` can indicate if the port is connected but unpowered. Ensure PoE is enabled with commands like `power inline auto` and that the port is not error-disabled .
- o **Cable Problems** Poor-quality or damaged Ethernet cables can prevent power delivery while still allowing data transmission. Use Cat5e or higher cables, and for higher PoE standards (PoE+, PoE++), Cat6 or Cat6a is recommended. Cable length should not exceed 100 meters; longer runs may require PoE extenders .
- o **Device Compatibility and PoE Standards** The powered device (PD) must be compatible with the PoE standard provided by the switch (e.g., IEEE 802.3af, 802.3at, or 802.3bt). Mismatched modes (Alternative A/B or 4-pair) can prevent power delivery even if the device shows a network link .
- o **Hardware or Switch Faults** Faulty switch ports or internal PoE components can cause power failure. Testing the PD on a different port or using a known working device can help isolate the problem .

Troubleshooting Steps

- o **Verify Port Status**
 - o Check if the port is administratively up (no shutdown) and PoE is enabled (`power inline auto`).
 - o Use `show power inline` to confirm the port's power status.
- o **Check Power Budget**
 - o Ensure the total power required by all connected devices does not exceed the switch's available PoE budget.
 - o Consider reducing the number of devices or upgrading to a higher-capacity switch if necessary.
- o **Inspect and Replace Cables**
 - o Confirm cable type and length. Replace damaged or non-compliant cables.
 - o For long runs, consider PoE extenders or higher-quality cables.
- o **Test Device Compatibility**
 - o Verify the PD supports the PoE standard and mode provided by the switch.
 - o If possible, test the device on a different PoE switch or port.

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- o Reset or Reconfigure the Switch Port
- o Disable and re-enable PoE on the port.
- o Reboot the switch if necessary to clear transient errors. By systematically checking power budget, port configuration, cabling, and device compatibility, most PoE issues where a device shows a network signal but receives no power can be resolved .
