Overview of RFN LCR Switches

Eaton's RFN LCR switch family (LCR-6200RFN, LCR-6600RFN, LCR-6700RFN) is designed to provide advanced load control and power quality protection using radio frequency (RF) mesh network communications. These switches allow utilities to broadcast a single command to control one or multiple devices simultaneously, enabling fast and efficient demand response events. The RFN switches use TrueCycle(R) smart load control algorithms to maximize demand reduction while maintaining customer comfort and automating measurement and verification data collection .

- o LCR-6200RFN: Optimized for HVAC systems and strip heat, with a single 5-amp relay for cycling HVAC control circuits.
- o LCR-6600RFN: Versatile, with multiple 5-amp and 30-amp relays, allowing individual or simultaneous control of multiple loads.
- o LCR-6700RFN: Designed for retrofitting legacy load management switches. The RFN designation indicates that the switch is RF mesh network-enabled, allowing two-way communication for monitoring, control, and integration into a broader smart grid or demand response system.

Power Distribution Box Functionality

A power distribution box is a centralized enclosure that distributes electrical energy to multiple devices while providing protection and control. In DC systems, such as those from Ferroamp, the Power Distribution Box connects devices on a DC grid to an EnergyHub. Models like Power Distribution 5, 8, and 15 can connect 5, 8, or 15 devices, respectively, and are IP65 rated, suitable for indoor or outdoor installation . Multiple boxes can be connected in parallel to expand the system, with careful cabling to handle the total load. In general, power distribution boxes contain circuit breakers, relays, and contactors to manage energy flow safely, reduce voltage where necessary, and distribute power to connected equipment . They are essential for both AC and DC systems, providing centralized control, protection, and monitoring.
