Sierra Leone's power sector is undergoing a transition, characterized by persistent challenges and emerging opportunities. Electricity access remains limited, with only 30% of the population connected nationally and less than 5% in rural areas. Its state-owned electricity distribution company, EDSA, is mired in debt and has a long history of operating losses, both technical and commercial due to an old and poorly-maintained distribution network, illegal connections, and non-payment from customers, and these losses are compounded by.
