For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems or extenders to maintain consistent signal strength throughout the property . 6. Optional Features: Advanced routers may include Quality of Service (QoS) settings, parental controls, and support for VLANs, which can help optimize network performance and security for multiple users .
