ST connectors are round, twist-lock connectors commonly used with multimode fiber, while SC connectors are square, push-pull connectors suitable for both multimode and single-mode networks.

ST Connectors

Design and Features: ST (Straight Tip) connectors have a round body with a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism that ensures a secure connection. They use a 2.5 mm ferrule to hold the fiber and are keyed for proper orientation during insertion . **Applications:** ST connectors are widely used in multimode fiber networks, particularly in industrial, military, and legacy LAN installations. They are common in fiber distribution frames, patch panels, and multimode datacom networks . **Advantages:**

- o Robust and reliable in environments with vibration or movement
- o Easy to connect and disconnect with a twist-lock
- o Compatible with multimode fibers such as OM1, OM2, OM3, and OM4
- o Larger and bulkier than SC connectors
- o Exposed ferrule can be prone to dust contamination
- o Less suitable for high-density applications due to size

SC Connectors

Design and Features: SC (Subscriber Connector) connectors have a square-shaped, push-pull design with a ceramic ferrule for precise fiber alignment. They are compact and allow for easy insertion and removal . **Applications:** SC connectors are used in enterprise networks, FTTH (fiber-to-the-home), CATV, and data centers. They support both multimode and single-mode fibers, making them versatile for modern network deployments . **Advantages:**

- o Simple push-pull mechanism, user-friendly
- o Compact, suitable for high-density panels
- o Reliable performance with low insertion loss and return loss
- o Compatible with multimode fibers (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4) and single-mode fibers (OS2),
- o Can disconnect if pulled sharply
- o Slightly larger footprint than LC connectors, though smaller than ST
