

# Sequence of Bundled Pigtail Reels

Bundled pigtail reels typically consist of 12 or more color-coded fiber optic pigtails, pre-terminated with connectors, arranged for efficient splicing and network deployment.

## Overview of Bundled Pigtails

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to incoming fiber cables in patch panels, splice trays, or terminal boxes . Bundled pigtails group multiple fibers together--commonly 4, 8, 12, or 24 fibers--into a single reel for organized deployment . Each fiber in the bundle is color-coded according to TIA-598 standards, which simplifies identification and reduces splicing errors .

## Connector Types and Fiber Variants

Bundled pigtails are available with various connector types, including LC, SC, FC, ST, and E2000, in both UPC and APC polish grades . They can be manufactured in single-mode (OS2, G.652D) or multimode (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4) variants, with tight-buffered fibers (typically 0.9 mm) for easy handling . The choice of connector and fiber type depends on network requirements, such as transmission distance, bandwidth, and equipment compatibility.

## Sequence and Color Coding

The sequence of bundled pigtails follows a standardized color code to ensure consistent identification during installation. For a 12-fiber bundle, the typical TIA-598 color sequence is: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua . This sequence allows technicians to quickly match fibers during splicing and patch panel termination, minimizing errors and downtime.

Bundled pigtail reels are widely used in data centers, enterprise LANs, FTTH deployments, and telecommunication networks . Key advantages include:
