

Setting up IP for Internet access via fiber optic direct connection to router

Article Overview

To access the internet via fiber optic, connect the fiber cable to an ONT, link the ONT to your router via Ethernet, and configure your router with the ISP-provided IP settings.

Step 1: Gather Required Equipment

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber signals to Ethernet; usually provided by your ISP .
- o Fiber optic cable: Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Ethernet cable: Cat6 or Cat6a recommended for high-speed connections .
- o Fiber-ready router: Supports gigabit speeds or higher, ideally Wi-Fi 6 or 6e for optimal performance .

Step 2: Connect Fiber to ONT

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home.
- o Remove protective caps from the fiber cable and ONT port.
- o Insert the fiber cable into the ONT's optical input port, ensuring proper alignment to avoid signal loss .
- o Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes), .

Step 3: Connect ONT to Router

- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the WAN port on your router .
- o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .

Step 4: Configure Router and IP Settings

- o Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly at 192.168.1.1 or as specified in the router manual), .
- o Enter your ISP-provided credentials if required (username, password, or VLAN ID).
- o IP Configuration Options:
 - o Dynamic IP (DHCP): Most ISPs assign IP automatically; select DHCP in the WAN settings.
 - o Static IP: If your ISP provides a fixed IP, enter the IP address, subnet mask, gateway, and DNS servers manually.
- o Update router firmware if needed and configure Wi-Fi security (WPA3 recommended) and network name (SSID), .

Step 5: Verify Internet Access

- o Check the router's WAN status to ensure it has obtained an IP address.
- o Test connectivity by browsing websites or pinging external servers.



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- o If using a static IP, ensure the IP matches the ISP's assigned range and gateway.

Tips for Optimal Performance

- o Place the ONT and router in a well-ventilated, dry area near power outlets .
- o Use high-quality Ethernet cables to maintain fiber speeds up to 10 Gbps .
- o For multi-gigabit setups, consider routers with SFP+ ports for direct fiber modules . Following these steps ensures your fiber optic connection is properly converted, routed, and configured with the correct IP settings for reliable high-speed internet access.
