Setting up a Fiber to the Home router involves connecting the fiber optic cable to an ONT, linking the ONT to your router, and configuring the router for optimal performance.

Required Equipment

To set up FTTH internet, you will need:

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber light signals into electrical signals for your router. Usually provided by your ISP .
- o Compatible Router: Ensure it supports fiber input via a WAN port or SFP module .
- o Fiber Optic Cable: Typically yellow with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Ethernet Cable: Connects the ONT to your router .

Step 1: Install the ONT

- o Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters your home .
- o Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated port.
- o Power on the ONT and wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .

Step 2: Connect the ONT to Your Router

- o Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port .
- o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 3: Configure the Router

- o Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly at 192.168.1.1), .
- o Enter your ISP-provided credentials to authenticate the connection.
- o Update the router firmware if necessary to ensure compatibility and security .
- o Set a strong Wi-Fi password and customize your network name (SSID) for optimal performance .

Step 4: Optimize Wi-Fi Coverage

- o For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems to extend coverage .
- o Place the router in a central location to minimize dead zones.
- o Avoid placing the router near thick walls or metal objects that can interfere with signal.

Additional Tips

- o Fiber to Ethernet Media Converters can be used if you need to extend fiber connections or maintain



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electrical isolation between devices .

- o Avoid bending fiber cables beyond manufacturer recommendations to prevent signal loss .
 - o Ensure the ONT and router are powered reliably; consider surge protection for sensitive equipment .
