A gray single-mode fiber optic patch cord is a high-performance cable designed for long-distance, low-loss optical transmission, suitable for data centers, telecom, and FTTH applications.

These cables are designed to minimize signal loss, with typical attenuation values of ≤ 0.4 dB/km at 1550 nm for OS2 fibers, ensuring reliable performance over long distances .

Construction and Features

- o Fiber Type: Single-mode (ITU-T G.652.D standard), often using Corning(R) SMF-28e fiber for superior performance .
- o Cable Jacket: Gray color is standard for single-mode cables, with options for riser-rated (OFNR) or plenum-rated (OFNP) jackets depending on installation environment .
- o Connector Types: Common connectors include LC, SC, FC, ST, and APC variants, with hybrid options available for specific applications .
- o Cable Diameter: Available in 1.6mm, 2mm, or 3mm PVC jackets to suit different cable management needs .
- o Design: Options include tight-buffered for indoor use or loose-tube/bend-insensitive for outdoor or high-density environments .

- o Attenuation: Low-loss performance ensures minimal signal degradation over long distances, typically ≤ 0.4 dB/km at 1550 nm .
