Technical Parameters

Key technical parameters for distribution boxes include:

- o Enclosure materials: Steel plates or insulating plates; wooden enclosures are not recommended .
- o Installation height: Fixed boxes should be 1.3-1.5m from the ground; mobile boxes 0.6-1.5m .
- o Electrical separation: Each equipment must have a dedicated switch and residual current device (RCD), following the "one equipment, one switch, one RCD" rule .
- o Spacing: Maximum 30m between distribution and switch boxes; horizontal distance to fixed equipment should not exceed 3m .
- o Frequency and voltage: Typically 50Hz AC, with rated voltages of 380-400V for low-voltage systems and up to 660V for motor control applications .

Compliance and Safety

Distribution boxes in Somalia are designed to comply with national and international safety standards, ensuring:

- o Proper earthing and grounding systems

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- o Mechanical stability and secure mounting
- o Safe connection to high-voltage switchgear without plug connectors
- o Clear labeling and component marking for operational safety

Context in Somali Power Grid

According to the Somalia Ministry of Energy and Water Resources, the national grid is expanding with sub-grids in Banadir, Central, Northeastern, Northwestern, Southern, and Southwestern regions. Distribution boxes are deployed to manage load demand, support urban and preurban areas, and integrate generation projects into the national grid . The boxes must handle variable loads, ensure reliable power delivery, and accommodate future expansion in line with the Optimized Cost Electricity Generation and Transmission Development Plan .
