

Standard Requirements for Welding of Frame Distribution Boxes

Preview

This fabrication and welding procedure governs the welding of components to the requirements of AWS D1. 1 (Reference 1) and Mechanical and Metal Trades Handbook 3rd Edition (Reference 2). Understand key welding methods, materials, design and quality-control for electrical enclosures -- from TIG/MIG to distortion control and standards compliance. Ensure cleaning of each weld edge. 4 KV Substation of the ratings indicated above. These Distribution Cabinets are to be outdoor type and to be fabricated out of 2 mm GI sheet steel. The body of the boxes shall have sufficient reinforcement with suitable size of channels keeping a provision for fixing and conforming to general low-alloy constructional steels.

The installation of the distribution box must be level and stable. According to inspection standards, the permissible vertical deviation for boxes with a height less than 50cm is 1.5mm, and for boxes 50cm

Distribution boxes shall be made of non-combustible materials; open distribution boards may be installed in production places and offices with low electric shock risk; enclosed cabinets shall

It is usual to deliver shop-fabricated beams and columns to site for erection. For best economy, the size of elements delivered to site should be as close to the maximum permitted by transport

The welding terms used in this code shall be interpreted in conformance with the definitions given in the latest edition of AWS A3.0, Standard Welding Terms and Definitions, Including Terms for Adhesive

The distribution box has the characteristics of small size, simple installation, special technical performance, fixed location, unique configuration function, not limited by the site, relatively common

The relevant standards, rules and specifications that a welding inspector should be familiar with at the start of a new contract are all the documents required for reference during the fabrication sequence

Allow the choice between manual welding and automatic welding on the same weld joint. After automatic welding, there is the possibility of additional weld buildup using manual welding.

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Welding & Assembly (Enclosure): Depending on the design, parts may be spot-welded together. For some larger boxes, frames are assembled using fasteners. Reinforcements are often
