- o Check Alignment: Ensure all edges meet neatly and the box maintains its intended dimensions. Adjust folds slightly if necessary to correct minor misalignments .
- o Secure Lid: If the box has a lid, fold it similarly, leaving a small gap if needed to allow easy opening and closing .

- o Paperboard Grain: Fold along the grain direction for smoother bends and stronger edges .
- o Weight Distribution: For heavy products, consider reinforced bottoms like snap-lock or auto-bottom designs to prevent collapse .
- o Consistency: Use mechanical scoring for large production runs to ensure uniform folds .
