- o Transfer Switches: In systems with backup generators, automatic transfer switches (ATS) switch power between the main supply and generator to maintain continuous electricity .

- o Material-Based: Metal boxes for industrial strength and durability; plastic boxes for lightweight, corrosion-resistant applications .
