A red light on a fiber optic router usually indicates a Loss of Signal (LOS), meaning the router is not receiving a proper optical signal from your ISP.

Common Causes

- o Fiber Optic Cable Issues: Physical damage, bends, or loose connections in the fiber optic cable can disrupt the signal and trigger a red light on the router .
- o ISP Outage: Maintenance or local service interruptions can prevent the router from connecting to the network .
- o Router or ONT Malfunction: A faulty router or Optical Network Terminal (ONT) may fail to process the fiber signal correctly .
- o Dirty or Improper Connectors: Dust or misaligned SC/APC connectors can block the optical signal .
- o Power Issues: Fluctuations or insufficient power can cause the router to lose connectivity .

Troubleshooting Steps

- o Check for ISP Outages: Visit your ISP's website or social media pages to see if there is a known service disruption .
- o Inspect the Fiber Cable: Look for visible damage, ensure the cable is properly connected to the WAN/ONT port, and check that connectors are clean and secure .
- o Reboot the Router/ONT: Turn off the device, unplug it from the power source for 30 seconds, then reconnect and power it on. This often resolves temporary signal issues .
- o Verify All Connections: Ensure power, LAN, and fiber cables are firmly connected. Replace any damaged cables .
- o Check for Overheating: Make sure the router is in a ventilated area and not overheating, as this can affect performance .
- o Factory Reset (if needed): If the red light persists, perform a factory reset by pressing the reset button for 10-15 seconds, but note this will erase custom settings .

When to Contact Your ISP

If the red LOS light remains solid or blinking after performing the above steps, it may indicate a deeper issue with the fiber line or the ONT. Contact your ISP with details of the troubleshooting steps you have taken so they can perform line testing or dispatch a technician . By following these steps, most red light issues can be resolved without professional assistance, but persistent problems usually require ISP intervention.
